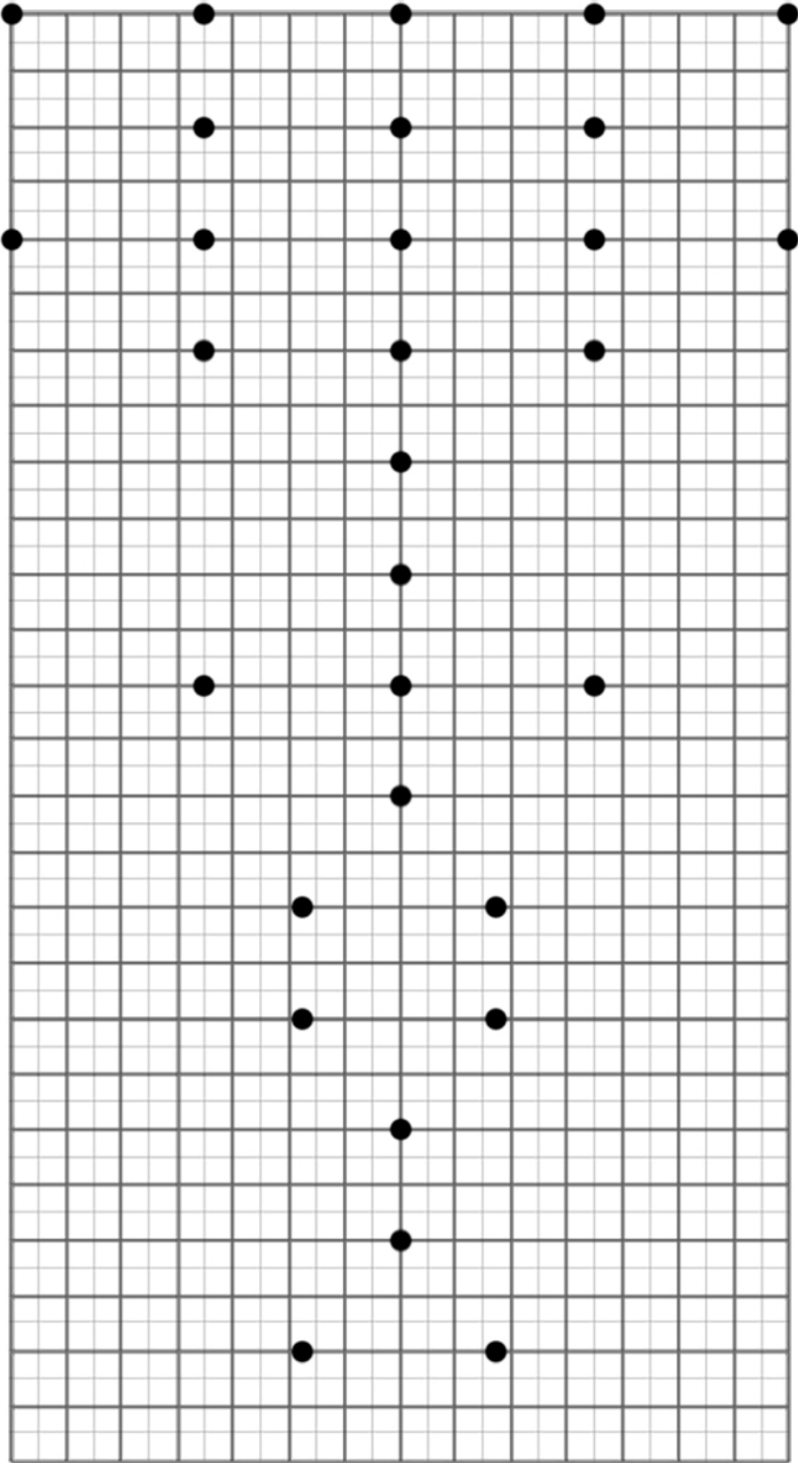
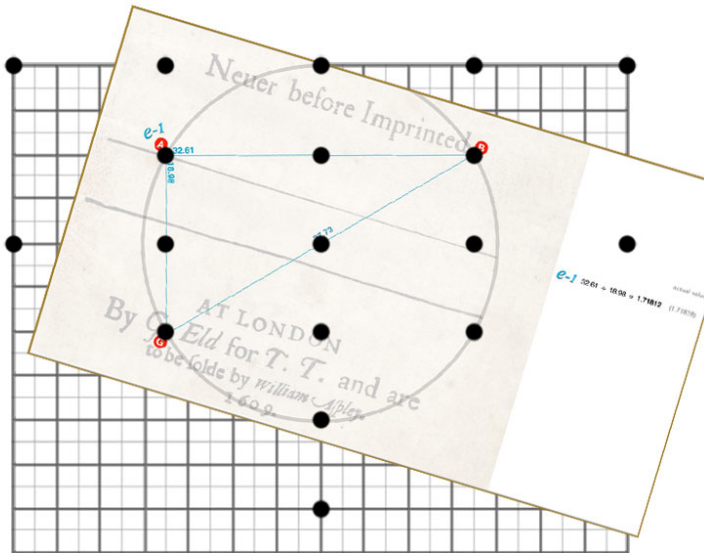


First image I am sharing is the grid and stops that came up when centering the stops in the Sonnets Dedication poem:





circumradius = 4.03113 <sup>?</sup>



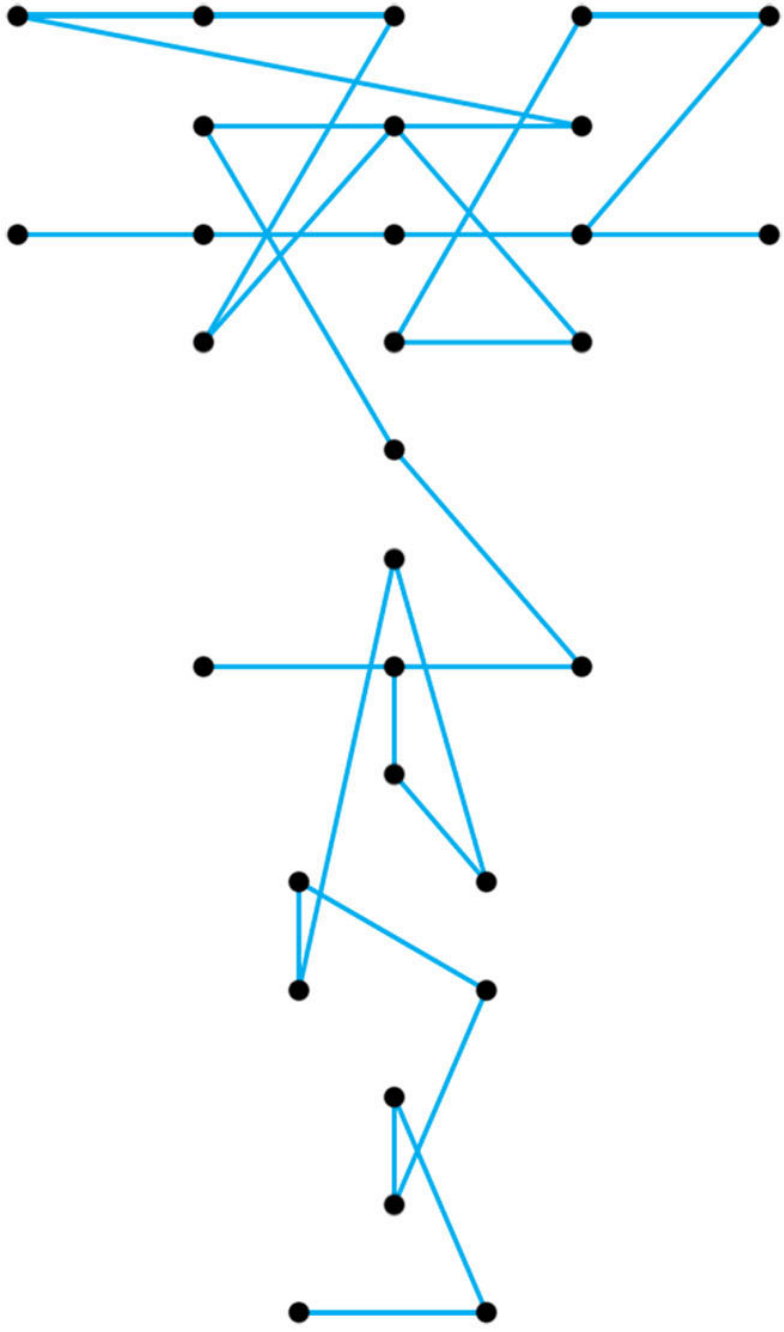
